1. Remember that during Great Lent – and the rest of the year – the sacrament of confession is a necessary part of your spiritual self examination. Confession is always available by appointment, but also during the following specific times during Great Lent: after small compline on Monday evening (about 7:30); before pre-sanctified liturgy on Wednesday nights from 5:30 to 6:15; before the Salutations to the Theotokos on Friday night, from 5:30 to 6:15; after Soul Saturday Liturgy (for the next two weeks); before Great Vespers from 3:30 to 4:30 and afterwards; and after Divine Liturgy on Sunday. I'll announce a Holy Week schedule later.
