4. Upcoming at *St. Nicholas*:

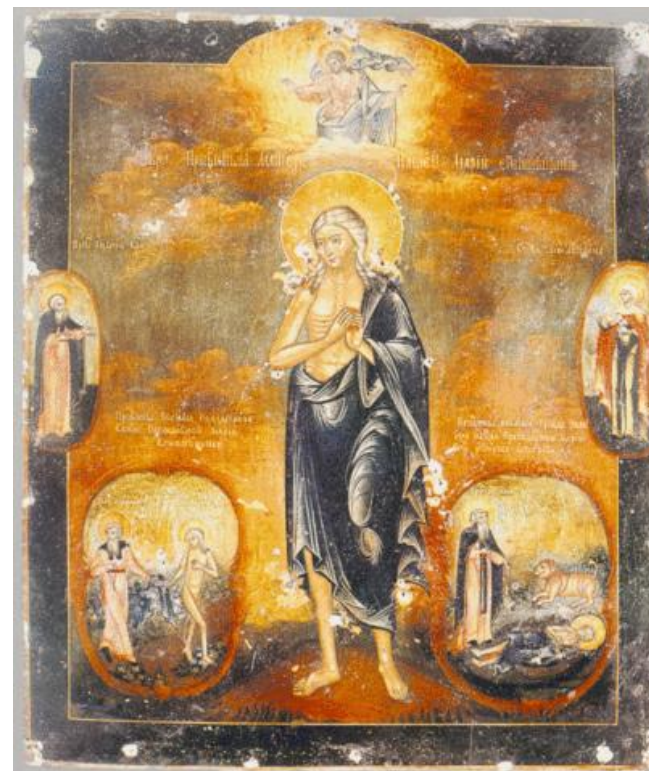
