Sunday April 25	Sunday of the Paralytic (Divine Liturgy, 10:00 am)

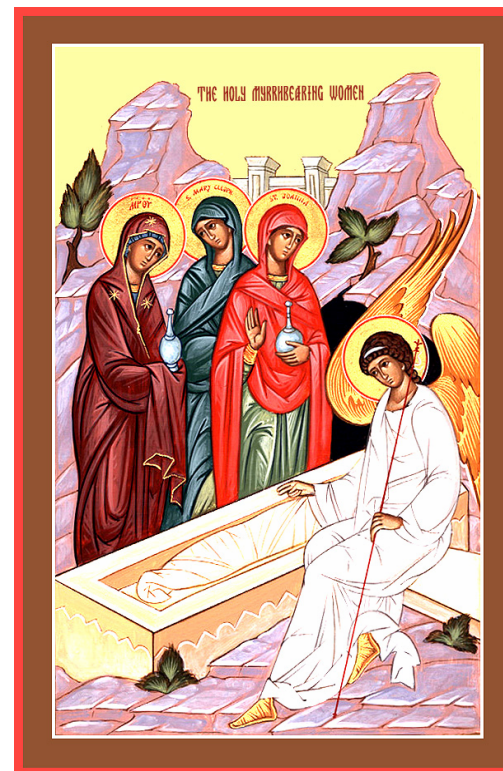
